Halifax Beautification Committee Meeting Minutes - 3/8/21

Jeanne called the meeting to order at 3:15 p.m.

- 1. The minutes for the meeting on 2/23/21 were approved unanimously.
- 2. Jeanne brought the committee up to date on the current budget. The General Expense account contains \$335.05. The Gift Fund contains \$2. The Peg Fitzgerald Garden fund contains \$3,737.50.
- 3. We discussed the contract with C-Mac for the cleanup of the Peg Fitzgerald Garden twice yearly. Amy suggested putting the contract out for bid to give other local companies a chance. The committee will select one of the bids at the next meeting on April 12, 2021.

4. Spring Clean-Up Day

Jeanne made a motion to pay no more than \$10 to print 20 copies of the Spring Clean-Up Day flyer. Michelle seconded it. All were in favor.

Members will pick up the flyers and hang them at businesses around town.

Michelle did not hear back from dumpsters.com about a potential dumpster donation. She agreed to reach out to Noonan Waste.

Amy is going to investigate a possible source of free trash bags through Keep Massachusetts Beautiful.

Jeanne will reach out to Buzz Around and Halifax Express to get publicity for the upcoming event.

Michelle made a motion to purchase 50 grabber tools for \$2 each, a total of \$100. These will be distributed to volunteers on Clean-Up Day. Adrian seconded. All were in favor. Jeanne will place the order.

Jeanne is going to ask Walmart for a donation of medical gloves to give away to volunteers on Clean-Up Day. If they are unable to, we will discuss purchasing some at the next meeting.

Final planning for Clean-Up Day will take place at the next meeting (April 12, 2021).
