

Halifax Beautification Committee Meeting - March 7, 2022

Jeanne called the meeting to order at 1:07 p.m.

1. Jeanne made a motion to approve minutes from February 23, 2022 meeting as written. Jill seconded the motion. All were in favor.

2. Discussed that there have been 11 vendor fair applications so far. Discussed potentially having an overflow tent outside in case there were too many vendors to fit inside.

Jeanne found outlets outside situated near the Peg Fitzgerald Garden. Vendors who need electricity can use this.

Discussed waiving the fee for nonprofits at the fair. Jeanne motioned to allow a table for foster care promotion with no fee. Michelle seconded. Everyone was in favor. Jeanne made second motion to allow any nonprofit who applies to get a table at no cost. Adrian seconded. All were in favor.

Discussed putting a donation box at the front door of the Town Hall to benefit the Beautification Committee. Jill volunteered to make a box out of upcycled trash.

Discussed reaching out to the police and fire departments to invite them to have tables at the fair, if they'd like. Jeanne agreed to reach out to the chiefs.

Discussed potentially having shifts for committee members at the fair. Adrian, Amy and Michelle agreed to stay the entire six hours. Jeanne will be there for the first and last few hours. Jill will be there from start until she has to leave.

Discussed alerting current vendors that tables will be arranged for them (indoor Great Hall vendors only).

3. Next meeting was scheduled for March 28, 2022 at 1 p.m.
