Many of the bushes are dying bc of root rot and/or lack of water. C-MAC needs to move some of the mulch that is mounded incorrectly around the remaining (live bushes) and weed. The committee would like to plant some bulbs in the fall, and some perennial flowers in the spring.
- Committee would like to plant some dune roses in front of Halifax Elementary school. This idea will be re-visited in the winter.
- Planters all over town and are supposed to be being kept up by various businesses and or town offices (Library, Council on Aging, Fire Station, etc). SG will contact these various places to see if they still want the planters.
- Committee would like to plant some evergreens over by the War Memorial monuments. JG will make a list of small evergreen bushes.
- JG suggested an Instagram account and will look into it.
- SG wants to have Aaron the Land Steward from Burrage to do a community talk at the Old School House. She will contact him.
