The Halifax Beautification Committee would like to thank you for all the support you and the highway department have given over many years for the Clean-Up days and weeks by securing dumpsters and when needed picking up larger littered items and/or larger piles of litter.

The committee has been made aware that at least 3 retail establishments in town are in violation of Chapter 233 of Halifax's By-Laws. This by-law bans plastic carryout bags. Rodney's Kitchen, Twin Lakes Liquor, and Happy Dragon Chinese Restaurant are utilizing plastic bags at check out. The by-law states that the Highway Surveyor is responsible for the enforcement of this by-law.

The committee requests that you contact these businesses to demand immediate adherence to this bylaw and to follow through to make sure that the businesses continue to adhere to the by-law.
