MINUTES OF THE MEETING HALIFAX CONSERVATION COMMISSION

May 11, 2021

A meeting of the Halifax Conservation Commission was held on Tuesday, April 27, 2021 in the Board of Selectman's meeting room, first floor, Town Hall. Kathy Evans opened the meeting at 7:00 p.m.

Members present: Kathy Evans, Chris Hadorn, Ed Lane, Associate member Colleen Fiumara arrived at 7:12 p.m.

Appointments/Hearings:

7:00 p.m. - Notice of Intent: 22 Carver Street: septic system

Present: Peter Lyons of Collins Civil Engineering Group, representing Joshua Porter (present) Mr. Lyons presented plans, the septic repair (failed system) north of property is bordering wetland line and drainage ditch. Propose to abandon the existing leaching area and existing septic tank, provide a gravity run to new tank and field. The structures are 120 feet from wetlands, just decommissioning of the existing tank and install of new line is within 100 feet of BVW. No grading changes within the buffer and erosion controls will be in place, minimal grading in front yard, no trees to be taken down.

Mr. Hadorn asked if the Board of Health has approved the system yet? Mr. Lyons was not sure at this time. However, it has been submitted to the board. Anticipating approval from them and they are looking for a variance through them but shouldn't be an issue.
