- **Food Trucks**

Board of Health has confirmed permits for Loco Larry's and Mama Deb's. Susan Hill will follow up with Dean's Concessions, Southshore Smokehouse and All American Ice Cream to submit their applications and be inspected.

- **Other Issues**

Brian Wall has confirmed a face painter and a clown to make balloon animals at the fireworks. The committee has confirmed that CORI checks are on hold for all vendors until Selectmen and Police Department discuss the requirement. Flower & Soul would like to have an informational table and/or at the event. Jon Selig to discuss with the Selectmen. Committee decided to forego Cushman's Insurance Company offer to provide an inflatable obstacle course. Janice Hayward will discuss with them about a donation and having an informational table. Janice Hayward spoke with the Fireworks vendor, and the show was increased from \$5,000 to \$10,000 show. New contract signed and returned. Mike Hill will take to the Treasurer's office to generate the check for June 25th. Online T-shirt sales were not what we expected. SpecialTees has not confirmed numbers and our portion of sales. Susan & Mike Hill picked up staff shirts, prize shirts and 60 extra shirts to be sold at the event. Susan Hill will put posts on Facebook as we get closer to the event so people will know that the shirts are available.

- **Finances and fundraising**

Susan & Mike Hill met State Reps Kathleen La Natra and Josh Cutler to accept their donations for the fireworks. Each donated \$500. Those donations and a vendor fee of \$150 from NE Novelty were brought to the collectors' office to be deposited. Brian Wall presented a check for \$10,000 to Jonathan Selig.
