Painting and carpeting of the library is now expected to start the week of August 12.

The library's Dig Into Reading summer reading program is in its final week, with the Company H Puppet Show on August 8<sup>th</sup>. All of the Monday Night Madness events were extremely well attended, including the recent reptile show on July 22nd (done free by the Museum of Science, applied for by Marie Coady) and the family Dance Party on July 29<sup>th</sup>. Also, the weather cooperated beautifully for the Pet Show last night, August 5<sup>th</sup>. The statewide summer reading program, Dig Into Reading, is sponsored by the Holmes Public Library, the Massachusetts Library System, the Boston Bruins, and the Massachusetts Board of Library Commissioners.
