The Library Personnel policy was used to explain closing procedures to a patron who was concerned about the doors being locked 10 minutes before closing. The Library Director used the policy to explain to the patron that locking the doors prior to closing allowed the staff time to assist patrons in the building and safely secure the building before going home for the night. The Library Closing Policy also came into question during a recent day of inclement weather. This policy is clearly written and was able to address the concerns voiced over a delayed opening.
