New Enterprise Catalog is Here!

If you have been to the library or logged in from home, you may have noticed that the SAILS Network went live with the new Enterprise online catalog as of June 1st.

Using the New Catalog

It's best to log in with your library card number and PIN right away instead of browsing first and then logging in. Then you will see the catalog display customized for Holmes Public Library patrons.

One feature of the new catalog is you may select several items and place holds on them all at once.

For example, you might search author "James Pat-

terson", sort by publication date (newest to oldest), narrow the search down by selecting "Books" as the format, "Adult" as the age group, and "Large Type Books" as the subject, click the checkboxes beside the

first three titles, and select Place Hold(s) from the Select An Action menu to place holds on the latest three large-print titles for adults written by James Patterson.
