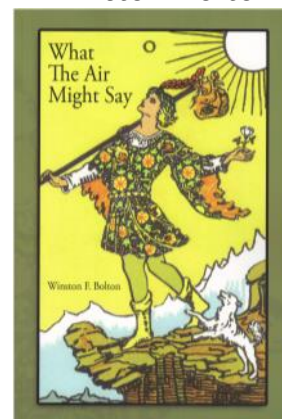
Starting in October, the names of all new and renewing members will be entered into a **quarterly drawing** to win a Friends coffee mug.
