The Friends are looking for an willing volunteer to fill a vacancy on the board, after Connie Sargent resigned. Thank you for serving, Connie!



Commonwealth Catalog Update

Wasn't the Virtual Catalog going away? Why is it back?

You may remember an announcement in this space about a new and improved Virtual Catalog called the Commonwealth Catalog. But the new Commonwealth Catalog has been indefinitely delayed, so libraries in the SAILS Network are back to using the Virtual Catalog to request items that are not in the SAILS catalog from libraries in other networks.

Who can use the Virtual Catalog?

Anyone with a valid library card may request items through the

Virtual Catalog that are not in the SAILS catalog. Start from *holmespubliclibrary.org*, click on <u>Catalog</u>, then look for the link to the <u>Virtual Catalog</u> on the lower left side.

How does it work?

Requested items are sent to the Holmes Public Library. They usually take 5-10 days to arrive and for you to be notified. When requesting, there is a place for you to enter an email address. If you do not use email, please ask us to request items for you, and we will be happy to do it!
