Fall Programming Update:

Children's-

- **Pre-recorded Early Literacy Story time**--Beginning September 17 and running for 5 consecutive Thursdays. This program will be pre-recorded and posted on a dedicated story time page. Story times will have an increased focus on early literacy and phonics instruction.
- **Bedtime Story time**—The plan is for this program to take place one Wednesday night a month @ 6:30PM. The first program is scheduled for September 16th. The program will consist on 2 bedtime stories and soothing songs. The program will take place on Facebook Live.

- **Children's Book club**—Live via Sails Zoom. This program will begin in October and the goal is to meet once a month. The program will be Live via SAILS Zoom. We are mindful of the time students spend on screen. Every effort will be made to make this a fun informal program with light reading and a connection with some classmates.
- Raising a Reader with Big Ryan—The South Shore Community Action Council is hosting Raising a Reader with Big Ryan Tuesdays September 22nd – October 27 @ 10AM. This is a Facebook Live Program for caregiver and child. Registration is encouraged for this event. This program will be publicized on our website and via Facebook.
