**ARTICLE I
Provisions of Fees
[Adopted 9-15-1997 STM, Art. 10]**

§ 88-1. Provision of fees; to be kept on file.

Copies of all current fees are to be provided to the Town Clerk by each department and are to be kept on file in the office of the Town Clerk for examination and inspection by the public.

ARTICLE II
Ambulance Rates, Fees and Charges
[Adopted 5-8-2006 ATM, Art. 45]

§ 88-2. **Charges for ambulance service. [Amended 5-10-2010 ATM, Art. 32]**

- A. **[Amended 1-04-16 STM, Article 2]** The Board of Selectmen shall have the authority to establish and to make changes to the list of charges for ambulance service provided by the Town of Halifax.

The charges for ambulance service provided by the Town of Halifax shall be as follows:

Service	Charge
Basic Life Support Emergency	\$1,205
Basic Life Support Non-Emergency	\$1,205
Advanced Life Support-1 Emergency	\$1,950
Advanced Life Support-1 Non-Emergency	\$1,950
Advanced Life Support-2 Emergency	\$3,010
Special Care Transport	\$3,462
Mileage	\$32 per mile

- B. All ambulance charges shall be due 30 days from the billing date. All charges which remain unpaid 180 days from the billing date shall be subject to an annual rate of interest of 12%.
- C. The Halifax Board of Selectmen shall have the authority to abate charges for ambulance services. **[Added 5-10-2010 ATM, Art. 32]**

ARTICLE III
**Collection and Disposal of Recyclable and Household
Hazardous Waste**
[Adopted 5-8-2006 ATM, Art. 45]

[At the 5-12-2008 ATM, pursuant to Art. 26, the Town voted to authorize the Board of Selectmen, pursuant to MGL c. 44, § 28C(f), and every other power thereto enabling, to establish and implement a fee system for the collection and disposal of recyclable and household hazardous waste materials generated within the Town and that such fees collected be deposited in the Solid Waste Retained Earnings Account.]

ARTICLE IV
Flammable Storage Licenses
[Adopted 05-13-2013 ATM, Art. 60]

§ 88-4. Fees for Flammable Storage Licenses.

The initial registration fee for a flammable storage license shall be fifty dollars (\$50). The annual fee for a flammable storage license shall be fifty dollars (\$50). The late fee for the failure to pay the license fee on time shall be fifty dollars (\$50) per month in whole or any part.
