## § 232-1. Disposal of recyclable materials in trash.

The disposal of any recyclable materials in any trash generated by the residents of the Town of Halifax and its municipal buildings, going to any landfill within the Town of Halifax or to any waste disposal facility outside the Town of Halifax, if such disposal is provided by the Town, is prohibited.

# § 232-2. Determination of what constitutes recyclable materials. [Amended 5-12-2008 ATM, Art. 28]

The determination of what materials are recyclable shall be made by the Highway Surveyor.

#### § 232-3. Scavenging prohibited. [Amended 5-12-2008 ATM, Art. 28]

The removal from a municipal facility, a public sidewalk or way or the usual point of residential rubbish pickup of any materials specifically set apart from the ordinary household rubbish for the purpose of being recycled under the recycling program of the Town of Halifax by persons other than those persons authorized to pick up such material by the Highway Surveyor or its agents is prohibited.

# § 232-4. Establishment of penalties; incentives for compliance. [Amended 5-12-2008 ATM, Art. 28]

The Highway Supervisor may set penalties and incentives to encourage compliance with this chapter. The Town shall facilitate the collection and disposal of said materials by providing containers or storage areas which are accessible to the public.
