Chapter 3

AGING, COUNCIL FOR

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[HISTORY: Adopted 3-4-68 Annual Town Meeting, Art. 42. Amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 3-1. Establishment.

A Council for the Aging shall be established.

§ 3-2. Membership; terms. [Amended 3-1-71 ATM, Art. 41]

Said Council shall consist of five (5) to eleven (11) members, appointed by the Board of Selectmen, who shall serve for terms of three (3) years.

§ 3-3. Chairman; Secretary.

Said Committee shall choose from its membership a Chairman and a Secretary.

§ 3-4. Duties.

It shall be the duty of the Council to coordinate or carry out programs designed to meet the problems of the aging in the areas of health, welfare, education and recreation.

§ 3-5. Council to be coordinating committee.

The Council shall act in a coordinating committee only with respect to municipal departments.

§ 3-6. Annual report.

An annual report shall be drawn up by the Chairman of the Council to acquaint the general public with the needs of the aging.
