§ 72-1. Superintendent of Cemeteries; duties; appointment. [Amended 5-11-2009 ATM, Art. 33]

The sole care, superintendence, management and control of the cemeteries shall be entrusted to a Superintendent of Cemeteries, who shall be subject to the general supervision of the Board of Selectmen and shall be annually appointed by it, said appointment to take effect at midnight on the end of the day of the annual town election each year.

§ 72-2. Price of lots to be fixed.

Lots in the Central Cemetery shall be sold at prices to be fixed from time to time by the Board of Selectmen.

§ 72-3. Record books to be kept.

The Superintendent, in addition to his other duties, shall maintain a set of books in which shall be kept the records relative to the sale and ownership of lots and records of interments.
