

## Town of Halifax Recycling Fee Abatement Form – Fiscal Year 2020

This is a two-page form. **Please complete both sides of this form.** This form must be either delivered or mailed to Halifax Board of Selectmen, 499 Plymouth Street, Halifax, MA 02338 no later than **thirty days after the issuance of the bill for the recycling fee**.

Filing this form does not stay the collection of your fees. To avoid loss of appeal rights or the addition of interest and other collection charges, the fee should be paid as assessed.

Fee Payer Information About Abatement Procedure				
An abatement is a reduction in the recycling fee for the fiscal year. To request a reduction or elimination of this fee, you must apply for an abatement. You may file an application if you are: the assessed or subsequent (acquiring title after January 1) owner of the property, the owner's administrator or executor, a person owning or having an interest or possession of the property, or a mortgagee if the assessed owner has not applied.  Your application must be filed with the Board of Selectmen by thirty days after the issuance of the bill for the recycling fee. Your application must be timely filed and received by the Board of Selectmen on or before the filing deadline or mailed by United States Mail, first class postage prepaid, to the proper address of the Board of Selectmen on or before the filing deadline as shown by a postmark made by the United States Postal Service. Filing an application does not stay the collection of the fee. Failure to pay the fee when due may also subject you to interest charges and collection action. To avoid any loss of rights or additional charges, you should pay the fee as assessed. If an abatement is granted and you have already paid the fee, you will receive a refund of any overpayment.
