Therefore, I would like to congratulate those have taken the time to show up, laugh and listen, try to ultimately take control of their health and well-being by just increasing their awareness. Some of the issues discussed: loneliness, depression, hypertension, diabetes, nutrition, bereavement, medications, sexuality lab tests, surgery, atrial fibrillation, insomnia, anxiety, general health and wellness. 
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
