Try This at Home: Overdrive E-Books & E-Audio

If you haven't tried Overdrive, the library's ebook service, in a while, there are more options now available:

- 1. You can read many ebooks in a web browser without downloading them, using OverDrive Read
- 2. You can read or listen to a book with a mobile device using the OverDrive Media Console App.
- 3. You can read or listen to a book on a computer with either Adobe Digital Editions (eBook) or the OverDrive Media Console software (audio).
- 4. You can transfer ebooks or e-audiobooks to an ebook reader or digital audio player such as an iPod, using Adobe Digital Editions (eBook) or Overdrive Media Console software.

One-on-one sessions are available for you to learn how to use Overdrive with smartphone, tablet, iPod, MP3 and/or ereader. plaver. Schedule one today!
