OverDrive E-Books & E-Audiobooks

Have you tried the OverDrive app yet on your tablet or phone?

Browse our growing collection of e-books and e-audiobooks by clicking on the OverDrive image on our Web site:



Sign in with your library card and PIN (usually the last four digits of your phone number).

You can specify eBooks or eaudiobooks, fiction or nonfiction, or browse featured collections. December Holiday collections are up now — one for adults and one for children. Click on "Kids and Teens Reading Room" to see only children's and YA titles.

Set your checkout period (from 1 to 3 weeks) and borrow items, up to six at a time. Some can be returned early, but not always.

Kindle Books may be selected from the OverDrive collection and you will be taken to your Amazon account or to the Kindle app to borrow them.
