Using the Overdrive App — It's So Easy!

To borrow a library e-book on a tablet, smartphone, or iPod Touch:

1) Make sure device is connected to Internet.

2) Download Overdrive Media Console from app store.

3) Open the app.

4) Follow onscreen instructions to complete initial setup of the app and select your library. If you aren't immediately redirected, tap "SAILS Inc." under "My Libraries."

(Search by zip code if you don't see SAILS, Inc.)

5) Sign in with library card barcode and PIN (last 4 digits of home phone) (Check off "Remember my login information on this device").

6) Search for a title, and tap "Borrow".

7) Tap "Download" and select file type.

8) After download, tap menu and select "Bookshelf". Tap book to open. Start reading!
