Time flies when you're having fun and things are certainly good at the Holmes Public Library. The June calendar is still in the making but there are some scheduled events that are noteworthy.

**Friends of the Library Book Sale** is Saturday June 4<sup>th</sup> from 10AM to 1PM. The Library is currently taking donations of used books. The books will remain in the community room for the entire following week to encourage shopping and hopefully bring in additional funds.

**Countdown to Kindergarten** is Wednesday June 8<sup>th</sup> from 10:30AM to 11:30AM. This is a collaborative event with Halifax Elementary School. Children entering kindergarten in the Fall of 2016 are invited to come to the Library for a private Storytime and meet our wonderful Children's Librarian. The book is entitled "Stories of Yesteryear Horse & Buggy Days". In accordance is Community Policy he will have copies of this book for sale the day of the program. Stephen has donated 4 copies to the Library for our collection.

**Summer Reading Kick Off Event** is Friday June 24<sup>th</sup> at 11AM. This program kicks off our Summer Reading Calendar for the children. We have a Magician book. On this day children can pick up their summer reading bags and sign up for programs. The Friends of the Holmes Public Library have generously donated \$965 for our Summer Reading Program.
