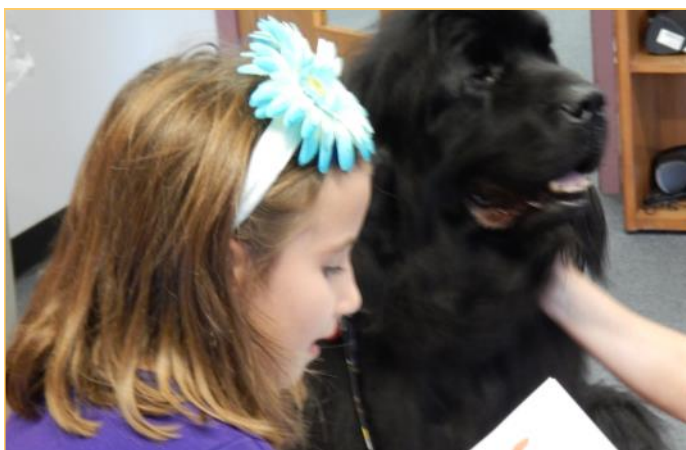
## Halifax Reads! Oct. 3-Nov. 17
