New OverDrive Update Coming Out Soon

What's different with the new OverDrive app update?

The updated version of the app being released in mid-September will eliminate the need for new users to obtain an Adobe ID, by having users set up an OverDrive account instead. (Current users who already have what was called an OverDrive One account shouldn't need to change anything.)

The OverDrive account will sync bookmarks and keep your place in the e-book on all of your devices. Also, ePub e-books will be able to be returned early! Also, the name will now be "OverDrive" instead of "OverDrive Media Console."

How do I get the app?

Download the OverDrive app from wherever you usually get your apps (e.g. GooglePlay, iTunes, etc.)

How do I figure it out?

Schedule a one-hour one-onone session with us; try the new, enhanced OverDrive Help feature; or check out our own new E-Book Help Page at http:// www.holmespubliclibrary.org/ eBooksHelp.html.
