

Halifax Planning Board Meeting Minutes October 19th, 2023

A meeting of the Halifax Planning Board was held on Thursday, October 19th, 2023, at 7:00pm in the Selectmen's Meeting Room Halifax Town Hall 499 Plymouth Street, Halifax, MA.

These minutes are an abstract of the Planning Board meeting held Thursday, October 19th, 2023, which are on file with the Planning Board Department and posted on the Town of Halifax website and Area58 Halifax's YouTube page.

Chair Millias calls the Halifax Planning Board meeting into session, states members present and read agenda into record.

Appointments/ Hearings:

• Continued Hearing – 314 Plymouth Street **Petition # 991:** Site Plan Review for a future Starbucks and Retail Auto Parts Store & Special Permit to allow a drive-thru restaurant.

O Chair Millias calls Attorney Robert Kraus to approach the Board and begin the presentation. Kraus introduces other attendees Aubrey Armstrong, Engineer; Gary McNaughton, Traffic Engineer; and Pat Brennan of PGB Engineering who completed the Peer Reviews for this project.

Kraus begins by addressing the status of the project stating that the concerns of the previous Peer Review that was done have since been addressed/remedied. He also states that at the Conservation meeting on 10/17, they approved the revised plans that were submitted along with the new Peer Review. Kraus mentions to the Board that their previous concern with easement access has been addressed and documented by the owner of the property, stating they will grant access when the project ends. He submits a copy of the letter to the Board.

Engineer Aubrey Armstrong joins Kraus before the Board to show the updated renderings of both Starbucks and Auto Zone. She gives a brief explanation of each of the rendering boards that are being presented by Kraus.

Pat Brennan approaches the Board regarding his Peer Review findings. He mentions that initially there were around 17-18 concerns that he had listed, but that most of them have since been remedied with the submission of the new plans in September. His most recent Peer Review letter lists only four points of concern that he wanted to mention to the Board.

There is a brief discussion about traffic impact and drainage. Mr. Brennan states that the coordination for both the proposed storage facility and the proposed Starbucks/Auto Zone need to be completed before any of the businesses can open. There is talk of it possibly being a condition of approval if need be. Chair Millias states that before any construction were to begin, he would like to know that everything is in place and agreed upon. Mr. Brennan reiterates that essentially their drainage won't function if the drainage of the self-storage does not function.

The Board discusses the fact that they cannot vote on it, as there are two members who aren't present at the meeting, and it is a Special Permit.

Kraus requests that the Board close the hearing to public input and allow the other two members to watch the recording and be able to then cast their vote.

Tom Alger of 340 Plymouth Street is present to speak about easements and water drainage issues stemming from the self-storage facility.

There is more discussion about drainage and making sure all drainage issues in that area are addressed/ and if one has impact on another.

More residents come forward to speak on the project.

Troup suggests they not close the meeting to public input, and it be continued to the next meeting so that Mr. Brennan can make sure he has all drainage issues that were spoken about calculated and in writing, and any new information that comes through should be visible and accessible to the town.

Gaynor agrees.

Kraus addresses the Board and requests the next meeting be equipped with Zoom so that engineer and other members of the team can attend without physically having to travel for it again.

MOTION to continue hearing to the next 11/2/23 Planning Board meeting with Zoom previsions to be made to accommodate the team members of the project at 314 Plymouth St.
