Dear Halifax Community,

The Town of Halifax will be holding a special election on Tuesday, November 8th at the Halifax Elementary School. The Town will elect two Selectmen: one with a term expiring in 2024 and the other expiring in 2025. For anyone interested in running for either position, nomination papers will be available in the Town Clerk's office starting tomorrow Wednesday, August 31st at 8 AM.

I will say the response to last week's resignations has been tremendous, not only from people here in Halifax, but from folks far and wide. People from every corner and all walks of life have approached me with the same question: "What can I do to help?" One possibility—volunteer to be a poll worker!

Many of our current poll workers are already going to be used for the state election process and Mass. election law says we need to use our own separate workers to handle our town election even though it's at the same time and place.
