**§ 3-1. Establishment.**

A Council for the Aging shall be established.

**§ 3-2. Membership; terms. [Amended 3-1-71 ATM, Art. 41]**

Said Council shall consist of five (5) to eleven (11) members, appointed by the Board of Selectmen, who shall serve for terms of three (3) years.

**§ 3-3. Chairman; Secretary.**

Said Committee shall choose from its membership a Chairman and a Secretary.

**§ 3-4. Duties.**

It shall be the duty of the Council to coordinate or carry out programs designed to meet the problems of the aging in the areas of health, welfare, education and recreation.

**§ 3-5. Council to be coordinating committee.**

The Council shall act in a coordinating committee only with respect to municipal departments.

**§ 3-6. Annual report.**

An annual report shall be drawn up by the Chairman of the Council to acquaint the general public with the needs of the aging.
