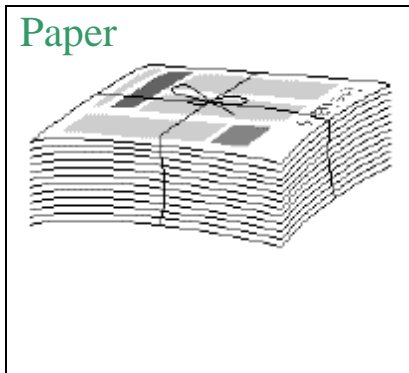
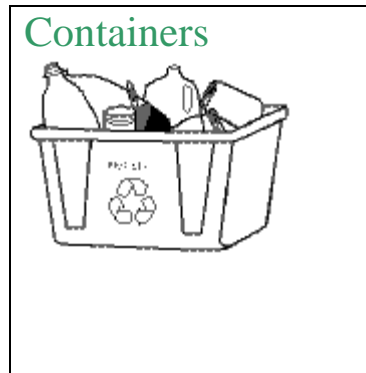


HALIFAX CURBSIDE RECYCLING

The following four materials are collected at the curb in a simple two-sort system:



Place together in paper bags or tied (to prevent litter) beside or on top of bin



Rinse and place together inside a green Town of Halifax Recycling Bin

- ◆Newspaper, with inserts
- ◆Brown paper bags

Junk mail, catalogs, food boxes, Magazines, cardboard no larger than 20x20 inches

- ◆Plastic bottles and jars. #1 thru #7 plastic
- ◆Metal food cans, aluminum foil, metal caps from jars, pie plates. No paint or aerosol cans.
- ◆Glass bottles and jars only. Remove lids, corks; labels may stay on bottles. No broken or other glass such as dishes, light bulbs window or auto glass

DID YOU KNOW?

That the Recycling Center does not accept household trash.

The Town of Halifax recycled 313,140 lbs (157.50 Tons) of newspaper in 2003.

Non-Profit organizations collect nickel deposit containers at the Recycling Center.

Trash and recycling must be curbside by 7 am.

The Recycling Center sells compost bins at a reduced rate.

All residents must have a green Town of Halifax recycling bin in order to have recycling picked up curbside.

Large Items may be picked up curbside on special days in April and September.

RECYCLING CENTER DOES NOT ACCEPT HOUSEHOLD TRASH

BAG PROGRAM: Residential trash is collected weekly and only at the curb. Only Town imprinted Bags placed curbside prior to 7 am will be picked up. Whenever a scheduled collection day falls on a holiday, that day's collection and all remaining collections that week will be delayed one day.
